Home-link books

When you drop your child off, please put your child's home-link book into their group's coloured tray for their keyworker to write comments and updates.

Toys from home

We ask that children do not bring toys from home as they may get broken or lost. If an item or toy is connected with the letter of the week, please hand it to a member of staff.

Sickness

For incidents of sickness and diarrhoea, children are not to return to pre-school until 48 hours have passed after the last incident of either problem.

We play outside, whatever the weather!

As the weather gets warmer, please ensure your child brings a named sun hat to pre-school. Please can we ask you apply sun cream to your child (if necessary) before bringing them to pre-school. If it is wet, please provide a pair of named wellington boots in addition to ordinary shoes for indoor play.

Named clothing

Please always name all of your child's clothing.

Nappies

Please provide nappies and place them in named pockets on the girls' toilet door. Please avoid pull-ups unless they have velcro sides, or unless the child is taking themselves to the toilet. During potty training it is easier to have elasticated waists and not belts on trousers. If your child is in nappies and is sore, please provide cream (named) for us to use. Thank you.
